

## How To Change Home App

1. Create a new page, go to **(IMAB) Pages** -> **New Page or Overwrite Page**, then fill title example "home", then click **Create Page** Button

2. Then go to **(IMAB) Pages** -> **Section Page Manager**, click star icon

**Page Manager**

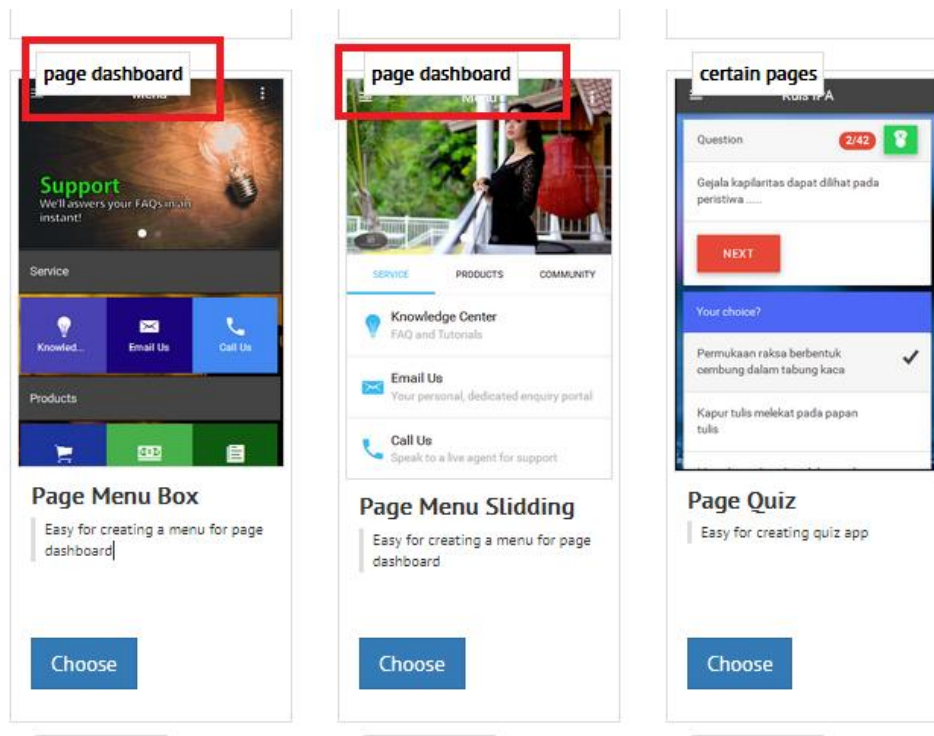
The rules that apply are:

- Key icon mean lock/unlocking a page that cannot be edited and star icon with green background mean the first page will appear and page without star can not used for a link.
- Link in webView, AppBrowser or Iframe cannot connect to app.

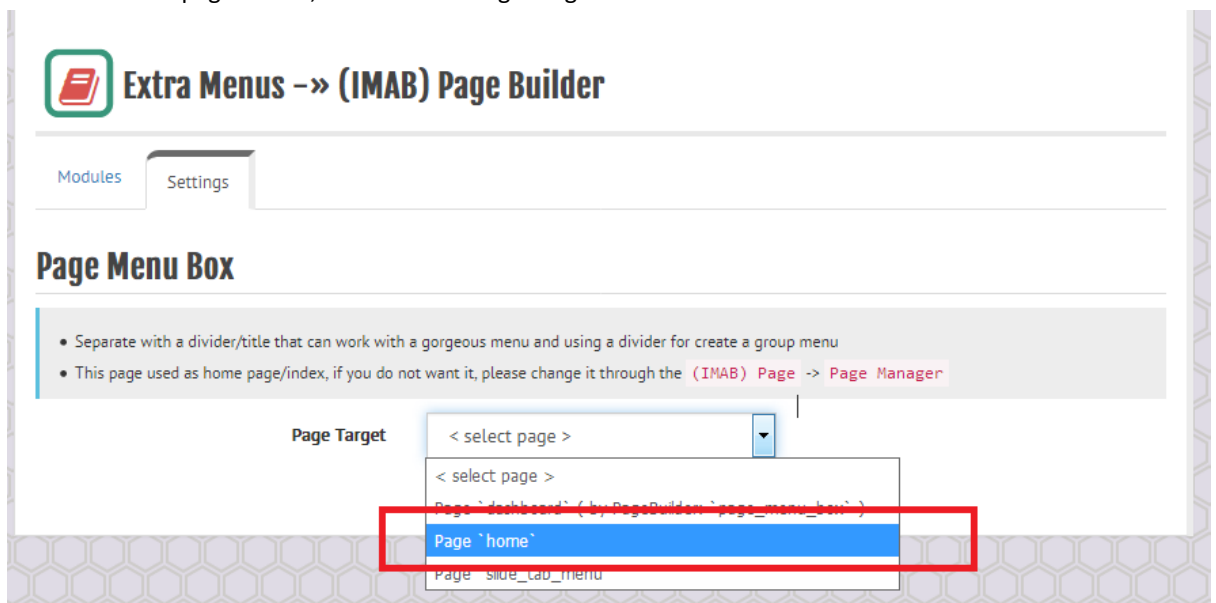

3. Now the index page has changed, you can create the page using the "Smart Code Builder" in the page editor or use **Pagebuilder**, now we are using Page Builder, go to Extra Menu -> Page Builder, use page builder with heading "Page Dashboard"



4. Select a module pagebuilder, then for field Page Target select "Home"



5. If you want still to edit, go to (IMAB) Pages, select page "home", don't forget unlock before edit.
